

This happens each end of the liturgical year, as we conclude our calendar with the Solemnity of Jesus Christ King of the Universe. This helps lead us into the two-fold character of Advent, as we anticipate the eschaton (culmination of all things) and the Incarnation.

We had a great beginning to Sunday School for children this past weekend, with around 20 children participating.

Our adult faith formation activities begin on October 8th, with a 5-part series I'm leading on the Mass, concurrent with Sunday School for Children. This is a great opportunity to renew our understanding of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass before the liturgical year changes over.


