

A Message from Father Tom....


"Let us beset the just one, because he is obnoxious to us."

Jesus and the Jewish Roots of the Eucharist Tuesday Book Club—New Session begins October 1

Dr. Brant Pitre explores ancient Jewish beliefs about the Passover of the Messiah, the miraculous Manna from heaven, and the mysterious Bread of the Presence. As he shows, these three keys—the Passover, the Manna, and the Bread of the Presence—have the power to unlock the original meaning of the Eucharistic words of Jesus. Along the way, Dr. Pitre also explains how Jesus united the Last Super to His death on Good Friday and His Resurrection on Easter Sunday.
