

A Message from Father Tom...

The prophet Daniel prophesied that The Son of Man would appear on a cloud and be granted dominion; in the Acts of the Apostles and the gospel today, we see that account echoed. It is good and necessary that Jesus return to the Father, for the descent of the Holy Spirit (which we celebrate next weekend at Pentecost) and that he could serve as the great High Priest in the true Holy of Holies which is the heavenly temple.

This is the mode by which he constantly mediates our relationship with his Father in his own glorified flesh. This is intertwined with his judgement seat, whereby he is keenly aware of all of us, as we have life in him through our baptism, and are presented to the Father through our participation in his glorified body.


